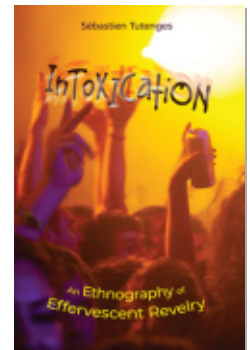

SÉBASTIEN TUTENGENS is an associate professor at the Department of Sociology at Lund University and the editor-in-chief of *Nordic Journal of Criminology*. He has previously worked as postdoc at Oslo University and associate professor at Aarhus University. He has a master's degree in anthropology from Copenhagen University and a PhD in sociology, also from Copenhagen University. His research is broadly concerned with risk-taking behaviors. In particular, he is interested in how people experience and make meaning of intoxication, violence, and extremism. These interests have resulted in years of studying young people in a variety of risk-prone environments, including nightclubs, music festivals, drug markets, and seaside resorts in Spain and Bulgaria. Tutenges has published a wide range of book chapters and articles, including in *Addiction*, *Alcohol & Alcoholism*, *American Journal on Addictions*, *BMC Public Health*, *British Journal of Criminology*, *European Addiction Research*, *International Journal of Drug Policy*, *Leisure Studies*, *Tourism Management*, *Tourist Studies*, and *Journal of Youth Studies*.
